

About the town

Villa de Leyva was founded in 1572 in the Valley of Zaquencipá, which was once the territory of the Indigenous Muisca peoples, and has witnessed the history of the Americas.

From pre-Columbian eras, through the conquest and colonial rule, to the struggles for independence, the houses and streets that stand today in this town, are an architectural and cultural testament to each of those significant historical moments.







Nestled in the heart of Boyacá, a region known for its challenging mountain passes and high altitudes, Villa de Leyva has proudly nurtured many of Colombia's legendary cyclists. The town itself boasts a colonial charm with its cobblestone streets and ancient doorways. At its heart lies the magnificent Plaza Mayor, surrounded by historic edifices that transport you back in time and provide a rich immersion into the local culture of one of Colombia's most enchanting towns.

Apart from its architectural allure, Villa de Leyva is a treasure trove of diverse natural landscapes, ranging from the rainy Andean paramo to semi-desert zones.

The town's natural beauty has spurred a wide range of museums, hotels, restaurants, cafes, and craft shops, ensuring that every visitor can relish in entertainment, comfort, and an authentic connection with local culture.




In her role, she oversees all aspects of trip planning and operation, and she's there to assist you with any needs that may arise.

Cancellation and Refund Policies

If a traveler needs to cancel their reservation, the following policies apply:

First payment: No refund will be issued for this payment.

Second payment:

- Cancellations submitted before November 12 23:59 (Bogotá time): 50 % of the second payment will be refunded.
- Cancellation submitted after November 12 23:59 (Bogotá time): No refund will be provided.

Third payment:

- Cancellations submitted before November 12 -23:59 (Bogotá time): 50 % of the third payment will be refunded.
- Cancellation submitted after November 12 23:59 (Bogotá time): No refund will be provided.

In case of cancellations caused by legal limitations on tourist activities in the context of a health emergency, 100% of the total amount paid by the traveler will be converted into a credit in favor of the traveler, which may be redeemed in another tour offered by VILLA within 24 months following the cancellation date.

In case of cancellations by VILLA RIDE TO UNWIND, 100% of the total amount paid by the traveler will be refunded.
